## 2017 Sale Season

This year we are offering a pen of 5 March shorn rams at Hamilton Sheepvention on August 8th. Our on-property auction has been moved to **Friday 29th of September**, where we will be offering 120 Poll Merino rams.

### Hamilton Sheepvention Sale Team

**BR15094:** ET bred son of Brundanella 14002. Grandson of One Oak Poll B12014. This ram is out of an elite One Oak special stud ewe by Collinsville Majestic, ET bred from an elite One Oak special stud ewe. Brundanella 14002 is also out of a ewe sired by Collinsville Majestic. At 16.5 micron this is a fine wool sire that has great depth of breeding for frame, size and length of staple.

**B16006:** Special medium wool bred sire with an open outlook and hardy constitution. This ram has free growing quality fine wool on a meaty well structured frame. He is a type that will handle all conditions and round up quickly.

**LB15095:** This ram possess an excellent quality, rich stylish, free growing, long stapled wool on a very correct hardy frame. He is a sire bred to breed like himself. LB15095 is ET bred out of white 13062 and from the best fine wool ewe we have (she is by LB14001 - our best fine wool sire) LB14001 is by One Oak BK08020 out of a One Oak No 2 Special Stud Ewe.

**LB15098:** This ram is a full ET twin brother of LB15095. He has the same quality wool and hardy constitution as his father and is a sire that has the 'extra' in the wool. He is a heavier wool type with the brightness and nourishment of a dominate sire.

**B16010:** This ram is a very correct, rich quality woolled ram, bred out of the fine medium special stud ewe. He is also by LB14001.

## First and Second in the Lake Cargelligo Maiden Merino Ewe Competition

One Oak Poll clients have a long standing tradition of doing well in the Lake Cargelligo Ewe competition. This year saw Alan and Jenny Ireland coming first and the Worland Brothers, Doug, Brad and Glen coming second place.

"Alan and Jennifer Ireland won the competition with their 20-month-old One Oak Poll ewes, averaging 21.33-micron and 72.23 per cent yield which cut 4.82 kilograms per head of wool at six months of age. The Irelands achieve 119 per cent Merino lambing which also won them best financial flock with a Merino enterprise gross margin of \$262 per head.

The judges reported the Ireland flock to be an excellent line-up of commercial sheep and good all-round ewes, with notes on their even type, good crimp and nourishment, being well grown out with good confirmation and excellent management.

Second place went to the Worland Family Trust with their 20-month-old One Oak Poll ewes with 20.1- micron wool and 64pc yield, cutting eight kilograms of wool per head. Both Worland and Ireland flocks have been classed by Michael Elmes taking him to eight wins in a row in the Lake Cargelligo Maiden Merino Ewe Competition, and numerous placings. Worland Family Trust had a lambing percentage of 101pc and had a full 12 months wool on their backs."

They are a balance of rich, well marked wool on a large well structured frames. Sale rams will also be available for private selection after our on property sale.
